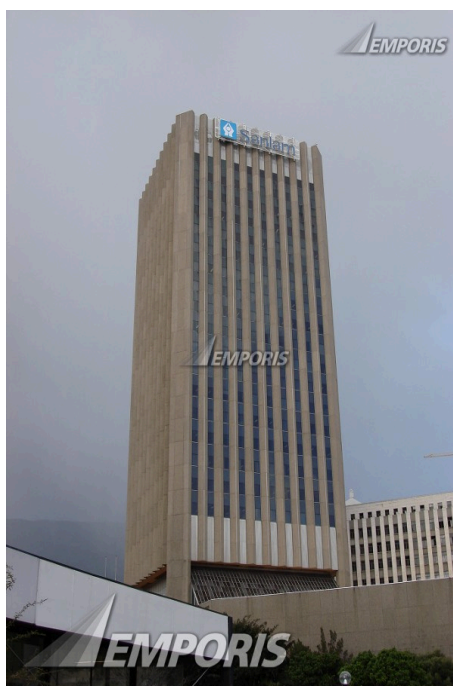

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Facts

- The Golden Acre was linked by a network of underground shopping concourses to the Cape Town railway station, Holiday Inn Cape Town and Picbell Parkade.
- This building is built over a large shopping centre and train station.
- The building is situated on the site where the original railway station was built.
- The location of the building marks the original shoreline, before land was reclaimed from the sea in the 1930s.
- The excavations for the Golden Acre uncovered ruins of the Wagenaar water tank (constructed in 1663), which are now on display behind glass in the underground shopping centre.
