- The hotel was named in honor of Toledo banker and businessman Jay K. Secor (1872-1921).
- The Secor Hotel was closed for about three months in 1934 to undergo a renovation overseen by Cleveland architectural firm Walker & Weeks.
- The building is now used for offices and is home to the Science Horizon Academy, the Toledo Opera, and several artist studios.
