changed to 400 feet, but the city council voted to approve this strikingly designed tower to exceed the limit by exactly 28 feet and 11 1/2 inches.

- According to KPF, subdividing the tower into distinctive slabs diminishes the building's apparent mass.
- A 3-story banking hall is comprised of a soaring, light-washed rectangle finished in panels of pear and anigre woods, Arabascata marble, and acres of stainless steel.
- The Contemporary Arts Museum in First Hawaiian Center has a light and airy 60-foot high vaulted atrium.
- This building replaced an earlier headquarters for First Hawaiian Bank and one of the first high-rises in downtown Honolulu, the First Hawaiian Bank Building.
